Refugee Assistance Guidelines

In September 2024, the Foundation introduced the [KCLF Refugee Assistance Guidelines](#), a pivotal step in ensuring clarity and consistency across our operations. These guidelines were developed to educate partner agencies—including The Department of Health and Welfare, The International Rescue Committee, and others—about the scope of services KCLF offers, as well as to establish clear and actionable boundaries for engaging with potential clients and agencies requesting support. The document serves as a comprehensive resource, outlining the eligibility criteria for assistance, the specific programs available, and the protocols for referrals and collaboration. By doing so, it aims to streamline communication, reduce misunderstandings, and ensure that resources are allocated efficiently to those in need of a helping hand.
